## Constitution

1. The Board of Governors has established a committee of the Board of Governors known as the Animal Welfare and Ethical Review Body (AWERB). The role of AWERB, as set out below shall be to ensure that the University complies with the Animal (Scientific Procedures) Act 1986 as set inulable ASPA Schedule 2C and Schedule 3.

The Body will have the right to request amendment to an application or reject an application in instances where evidence if not available that such full consideration has been made
- c) To review progress of current projects, including approval (or rejection) of proposed protocols and to review the outcome of completed projects in the context of the aims of replacement, reduction and refinement
- d) To ensure the adequacy of animal care and animal accommodation in relation to each licensed procedure and to advise on re-homing
